



Why the change?

We took a look at the quantity of plastic and glass water bottles we consumed and disposed of annually through our hospitality service on campus and found we were adding 25,000 bottles to the waste stream each year.

Chartwells investigated and took the initiative to order and install the Vivreau filtered water system for their hospitality and conference offer here at Brunel University. This replaced the glass disposable bottles used for conference bookings and the plastic bottles offered for the delivered catering events we have around campus.

This has not only resulted in a huge saving of disposables entering the waste stream it has had an impact on the carbon emissions associated with the deliveries to campus. Lower delivery weights effect the quantity of fuel used and therefore a reduced emission of approximately 1,676.80kg CO2.
